

WATER SERVICE CONNECTION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Rancho Carrillo Mutual Water Company (the "Company") has received requests for the procedures to connect lots to the water system;

WHEREAS, the Company has previously had an onsite plumber to provide supervision and procedures for installation of water meters in connection to the system; and

WHEREAS, the Company will adopt a procedure for the connection by the homeowner designed to provide adequate protection and security for the water system.

RESOLVED, that in the event the Company receives a request for connection or improvement of an existing connection, including without limitation, the installation of a water meter, the following procedures are to be adopted before approval of water service connection or improvement is made:

1. A designated representative of the Company shall be onsite and shall have authority to stop work in the event procedures, equipment or personnel utilized are not in conformance with the Company requirements;
2. The homeowners shall be responsible for all costs in connection with the installation, including the cost of the meter and reasonable fee for supervision and installation of the meter. The meter shall be installed by a designated Company representative and the meter shall remain the property of the Company;
3. The homeowners shall provide a licensed plumber holding a license or qualification suitable for a hot tap or related work on water Company facilities. The homeowners' contractors shall be fully insured and shall provide proof of licensure and insurance;
4. Only the hot tap method of installation shall be utilized;
5. The homeowners shall pre-dig the location and prepare for the hot tap, having available all necessary tools and equipment to complete the installation and to deal with any potential leaks or line breaks associated with the hot tap method. The contractors shall be prepare to isolate the line in the event of the leak and to complete repairs within two hours;
6. Homeowner shall clean up and close the site in accordance with Company standards; and
7. All costs and expenses associated with the installation shall be borne by the homeowner.
